Considering the growing demand from the students, the college sought for an additional strength of 100, which was later on accepted by SGBAU, Amravati, in 2002. Now the strength of the unit has risen to 200. The aim of this unit is to inculcate a spirit of service, a sense of togetherness and feeling of sacrifice among students.*
