The Department of History was established in 1968 in this college. At that time eminent historian Prof. N. C. Dixit was the head of the department. After his departure, Prof. Mohril joined the department, followed by Prof. C. B. Deshpande. After the retirement of C.B. Deshpande I joined the department in 2020.

In view of the growing strength of the students, the department started Post Graduate studies in 2010. Since then the subjects like Ancient India, Medieval India, Historiography, History of Marathas, History of Modern Indian Women, History of Social Reformers of Maharashtra and History of Social Movement in Maharashtra are being taught in the syllabus prescribed for the PG classes of SGBAU, Amravati.

In every academic year, various programmes are organised under the auspices of History Student Club for the personality development of the students. In the current academic session 475 students and 150 students have offered History for Under Graduate and Post Graduate classes respectively.
